**The Power Cost Adjustment Clause (PCAC) allows electric utilities to make monthly adjustments to customer bills when costs for providing power are above or below the average coast authorized by the Public Service Commission. When power costs fluctuate, the PCAC allows bills to be adjusted accordingly.**

Large Power (Cp-3) – Between 200KW and 1,000 KW		
Customers on this rate who are metered on the primary side receive a discount. A discount is also available for customers who own and maintain their own transformer/substation equipment

Must be primary metered & own their transformer/substation equipment		
Customer Charge	\$ 250.00	per month
On Peak Energy	\$ 0.0779	per kWh
Off Peak Energy	\$ 0.0589	per kWh
On Peak Demand	\$ 10.000	per KW
Distribution Demand	\$ 2.00	per KW

\*The fire flow capacity charge shown above covers costs to oversize Cedarburg's water system. This oversizing would not be needed for day-to-day water use, but is needed to ensure adequate water flow in the event that the water system is used for fire fighting.

### Renewable Energy Rates effective 8/01/2021

The Renewal Energy Program gives customers the option of purchasing blocks of their energy from renewable resources. Each block of renewable energy purchased is the equivalent of 300 kilowatt hours. *Please let us know if you would like to invest in renewable energy.*

Electric Rate Class	Charge
All rate classes (Rg-1, Rg-2, Gs-1, Gs-2, Cp-1, Cp-2, Cp-3, Cp-4, Ms-2 and Mp-1)	\$2.00 per 300 KWh block of renewable energy per month. purchase one or more blocks. The <i>additional</i> charge appears as a separate line item on your monthly bill. For customers opting to purchase 20 or more blocks, discounted rate is \$1.00 per block per month.

## COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY FEES

**Commitment to Community programs promote energy conservation and help qualifying households afford the energy they need.** All electric utilities in the State of Wisconsin are required to collect this type of fee. The last change in these fees was in January 2011.

Cedarburg Light & Water uses these funds to support programs such as conservation education in our schools, energy-efficiency improvements in local municipal buildings, bill payment assistance to income qualified customers and Wisconsin's Focus on Energy program.

Rate Class	Commitment to Community Charge
Residential	<b>Rg-1 &amp; Rg-2 accounts:</b> 3.00% of current month's electric bill not to exceed \$1.40.
General Service	<b>Gs-1 &amp; Gs-2 accounts:</b> 2.00% of current month's electric bill not to exceed \$2.00.
Power	<b>Cp-1 accounts:</b> 0.50% of current month's electric bill not to exceed \$4.00.
	<b>Cp-2 accounts:</b> 0.50% of current month's electric bill not to exceed \$6.00.
	<b>Cp-3 accounts:</b> 0.30% of current month's electric bill not to exceed \$10.00.
	<b>Cp-4 accounts:</b> 0.15% of current month's electric bill not to exceed \$25.00.

### Non-Standard Meter Service Charge effective 1-01-2018

Residential customers who choose not to have standard meter service on their premises will be charged a Non-Standard Meter Reading Charge of \$11.23 per month.

### Service Charges

A late payment charge of 1% per month will be added to all amounts past due.

A \$25 service fee is charged for all returned payments, plus additional bank charges that may be incurred.
