**TVs and computer monitors** must be complete and will be accepted as follows:

- Flat screen TVs and monitors **free**
- Plasma, tube, CRT, projection, wood case:
  - 32" and under **\$25 charge**
  - Larger than 32" **\$50 charge**
- Printers: **\$5 charge**
